

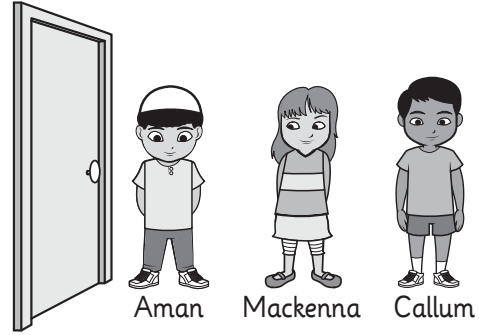
Ordinal numbers – 1st to 3rd
